CBSE RESULTS- FOR GRADEX & XII

Every year the school shows a stable growth in the academic excellence. On May 11th, CBSE Board Exam results were declared. Our school secured the centum results in secondary and senior secondary level. Miss Shan Joshlin of grade XII A secured 451/500 and stood school first at Senior Secondary level, and Miss. Libina Malcy of commerce group secured 99 in accountancy and became a subject topper in Idukki District, and Miss Nikitha Sony secured 452/500 in secondary level and became a school topper. These students made Montfort Valley School proud.

SCHOOL REOPENING

Montfort Valley School re-opened on 1st June 2023 with 630 students for the classes LKGteaching faculty to-XII, with 36 and 25non-teaching staff. The theme for the academic year 2023-24 was introduced "Lighten Yourself, To Enlighten Others", which implies that we must enlighten ourselves before we enlighten others. Montfortian educational system envisages, the charismatic development of the students in order to safeguard societal and national needs. The new school phase was introduced by the new principal and instructions were given to the students for the academic year 2023-24. The grade XI students were admitted on 9th of June for their regular classes.

ACADEMIC COORDINATORS AND NEW TEACHERS
