### **Teachers' Seminar**

Miss Vrindha scored A1 in all subjects 10th CBSE annual Board Examination, and secured the school First Rank. Miss Diyona Mary Saji secured cent percent in Malayalam, Master Simon Liju secured cent percent in Information Technology and Miss Sahana P secured cent percent in Tamil. We thank Mrs. Reena Thomas. Mr.Bijo and Mrs. Jamila for mentoring these

students. In Senior Secondary Miss Vaishnavi A secured school First Rank, Miss Meenakshi Biju and Miss Jayasree P recorded of academic distinction.

### **School re-opening**

MVS ignited the academic year 2025-26 with the slogan of “BE THE BEARER OF LIGHT AND A FORCE FOR GOOD”. The school re-opened on 9th June 2025 for the classes I - XII, with 704 students, 39 Teaching and 24 non-teaching staff. Bro. Principal welcomed and introduced the new teachers Rev. Sr. Tapaswini Pradhan, Mrs. Rajimol P K, Mrs. Anu P Reji, Mrs. Soumya and Mrs. Minnu Grace Raju have joined MVS family this year. Our administrator Rev. Bro. Joseph Thomas was transferred to Montfort school Chinnakanal as Director, we express our sincere thanks to Rev. Bro. Joseph Thomas for all that he had been to MVS and wish him best in his new responsibility. We welcome Rev. Bro. David former principal and correspondent of Montfort school – Perungudi, Chennai as our new bursar. He is one of the governing body members of Trichy Province. We extend a hearty welcome to Rev. Bro. David and a fruitful stay at MVS.

Academic Co-ordinators for this year are Mrs. Ambili Sabu for KG, Mrs. Ligin George for Primary, Mr. Sekar.S for Secondary and Mrs. Sweeja Thomas for Senior Secondary. They are doing an excellent job to impart holistic education for our students.

The KG initiation ceremony was conducted on 18th June and it was conducted by the Upper Kindergarten students. Block Panchayat president Mrs. Jisha Dileep, PTA President Mr. Shine George were the dignitaries to welcome the little princes and princesses of our school.

### **THE ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES**

Regular classes were held, syllabus was taught, every individual was monitored and nurtured with care. Students were encouraged to improve their learning abilities with effective communication skills. MVS provides a happy and joyful learning ambience. As per the school calendar exams were conducted for all the classes from time to time to ensure students’ academic performance.

Periodic Tests, Half Yearly exams, Terminal Exams for KG and Grade 1-5, Model Examinations for 10th and 12th grades were conducted in time. National level Olympiad exams for grade 3-to-9 in core subjects Maths, Science and Social Science were held during the year.

With a view of improving the performance of students collaboration with parents, timely PTA-Executive and PTA meetings were organized.

Class assembly is a platform for the children to exhibit their creativity of thoughts. The school always encourages the children to make use of the opportunity to showcase their God given talents: On every Tuesday grade VI – to XII, on every Thursday grade I – to -V and on every Friday the Kindergarten students conduct the class assembly.

On every Wednesday extra-curricular activities are offered as per the choice of the students. The following activities are offered: yoga, karate, Kung Fu, arts and crafts, musical instruments, Classical dance, Western dance, drums, skating and Abacus training etc...

To inculcate values among the students we have moral science classes as part of our curriculum on every Friday of the week.

First Friday of every month Holy Mass is offered for all the catholic students by our spiritual animators Rev. Fr. Dileep and Rev. Fr. Sumesh. We thank Rev. Fathers for their dedicated service at Montfort.

The teachers of secondary and senior secondary have attended the online webinar classes organized by CBSE board.

Every month we have staff meeting to create better teaching ambience and promote holistic education. Twice a week we have prayer meet in principal's office and to plan for the week.

### **Infrastructure Developments**

To improve the quality of learning at Montfort, the management is providing the necessary infrastructure. This year two new classrooms were added to the KG section with spacious washroom facility to the girls and boys. The building construction work is still on progress to fulfil the demands for the next academic year.

\*A new 26-seater bus was added to our school transport facilities for the benefit of the students from Suryanelli area.

\* Our computer lab is equipped with 20 latest AI supported computers for the use of the students. Grade VI and IX had written their SAFFAL online examinations and our school is declared as one the SAFFAL exam center by CBSE Board in alignment with NEP 2020.

\* New individual desks were provided to the senior secondary students for better classroom learning.

- \* The school has installed R O water purification system to provide clean and good drinking water.
- \* A new Drums kit and triple drum were purchased to create interest in learning musical instruments.
- \* To improve sports and games among the students Gym equipment were added to the school facilities.
- \* Our school is under CCTV surveillance cameras were installed inside and outside the class rooms to ensure the safety of the students.

Montfort Valley School have got student connect tie up program with the prestigious institution of IIT Madras. They have offered a number of certified online courses for the students of Grade IX to XII on core subjects. It will be great boon for their higher education, especially in the field of Data Science and AI, electronic system, Architecture and design, Aerospace, Ecology, Engineering, biology, Maths, Computer and Law. Our 12th students joined the course for this academic year and completed the course with flying colours.

### **Idukki Sahodaya Teachers' Seminar**

District level seminar was organized for all the teachers in Idukki at Viswadeepthi Public School, Adimali. Our teachers handling grade 10th and 12th Grades participated in the programs. The toppers of the schools, and the subject teachers were honored with prizes during the ceremony.

Students were given special onam Payasam to commemorate the occasion. Teachers had special celebration in the evening with traditional onam meal. Thereafter the school closed for Onam vacation.

### **Tour and Excursion**

A week-long tour to Hyderabad was organized for the students of grade VI – to-XII. 76 students accompanied by 7 teachers under the guidance of the Principal participated. It was a journey of exploration, learning and enjoyment.

The school also carried out one day trip to Wonderla for the students of class 3 to 5, Silver Storm for the students of class 1 and 2 and Jumanji Park for K.G students as part of our educational curriculum to enhance practical learning.

### **Visit to the Police station at Santhanpara (24th June)**

134 students from grade IX-to- XII along with 7 teachers visited Santhanpara Police Station on 24th June. It gave practical learning experience of police station and its support to the local people in keeping law and order.

### **Student Enrichment Program**

On 18th July a seminar on “Effective Public Speaking” was conducted for the students of grade VII. The resource person was Mr. Arun Jose, JCI Ernakulam, Queen Bees. Students actively participated in the program.

MVS hosted a Career Analysis Test (CAT) organized by Lions International at the school auditorium for students from grade IX to XII. Career guidance, drug awareness, teenager’s issues were the main topics of that session. They conducted an online aptitude test also for the same students.

In the month of January 2026 grade VII to IX will have a day of seminar on the topic “The importance of Values and the art of counselling”.

### **MONTFEST - COMPETITIONS**

School level Montfest cultural competitions were organized in two phases for all the students from KG -to – XII. The off-stage competitions took place on 26th and 28th of July followed by on-stage items on 5th & 6th of August. The following were the events conducted: Essay writing, versification, storytelling, pencil drawing, digital painting, painting crayon, collage, poster designing, painting (oil painting and water coloring), cartoon making, Mohiniyattam, Bharatanatyam, folk dance, Kuchipudi, light music, Carnatic music, mappilapattu, western dance etc....

It was a real cultural festival of the school, offering a platform for the students to bring out their inner talents in art, literature and visual arena. The best performing students were given an opportunity to participate in the district level Sahodaya competition.

### **Kid’s Fest**

A separate art fest was arranged on 19th and 20th of November for the students of KG,1st and 2nd. The parents and teachers of the lower grade ensured the vigorous participation of the kids.

### **District Sahodaya Aarav 2025**

The district level sahodaya Aarav 2025, off stage and on-stage competition was held on 13th, 19th and 29th of September at Viswadeepthi Public School, Adimali. For the 1st time in the history of Montfort Valley School we got the 5th position in Idukki district among 35 participant schools.

On 12th and 13th of November 7 students from MVS participated in 11 events in the state level cultural competition held at Labour India Public School, Marangattuppally.

### **Heart Day**

The young aspirants of KG, under the guidance of the teachers and encouragement of parents observed world heart day by coming in red attire to the school showcasing the importance of health. It was a visual treat to the entire school.

### **Food Day (16 October)**

KG students organized food day on 16th October. 100 plus variety dishes were prepared and served by themselves with the support of parents and teachers. It was delicious and thought provoking.

## **Achievements in Sports and Games - District and State level**

The under – 19 girls Throw-ball team, won the Idukki district Sahodaya championship trophy, in the match held at Christhujyothi Public School, Rajakkad on 8th August. Miss Riyana Celestine was selected as the best player of the year.

The girls' team of MVS got a direct entry for the state level Volley Ball Tournament held at Ernakulam on 1st August.

The under – 19 girls Volley Ball team added the glory to MVS by becoming the champions of two consecutive years of Idukki Sahodaya. The Volley Ball Tournament held at De Paul Public School, Rajamudi on 8th November. Miss Anna Mariyam John was selected as the best player of the year, and qualified for the state level tournament.

Our Boys football team under 17 and 19 team participated in Iduki Sahodaya Match held at Highrange School, Mattuppatty.

Master Renis J secured silver medal in Idukki Sahodaya Ball-Badminton Championship held at Munnar on 12th October.

In the Sahodaya Chess Championship Master S. Sanmenan of grade XII secured bronze medal.

Idukki district Roller Skating Competition was held on 28th September. 3 of our students participated. Miss Farha Fathima and Miss Faiza Mariyam have added 3 gold medals in each category and Master Abhiram Rajesh won 3 silver medals.

Sahodaya district level sports meet was organised by Vijayamatha Public School Thookkupalam at Nedumkandam. Our students participated in the meet and Miss Anna Mariyam John secured gold medal in Discus Throw, Miss S. Sanmathi and Miss Manjira vishalini secured silver medal in senior and junior girls shot put.

In the District level Karate competition, Miss. Olive Mariyam Prince of grade VII, secured first in fighting, and second in in Katta, Miss. Aarit Anna Prince of grade IV secured first in fighting, and Master. Anjelo Abel Rijo of grade VII secured third in fighting.

CBSE Cluster XI, Athletic Meet 2025 took place in Eranakulam, three students have participated and Miss S. Sanmathi secured bronze medal in under 19 girls Shot put.

We appreciate Mr. Rogan our PET master for training our children to make a remarkable achievement in sports and games this year.

### **Disaster Management Committee (18th July)**

A Disaster Management Committee was formed at our school on 18th July as per the request of the district collector with Principal as the President of the committee. Mr. Shaji A H and Mrs. Ligin George are the staff representatives. Delegates of BRC, Health Department, delegates from the Village panchayath, Police Department, Vice President of Rajakumari Panchayath, PTA Executive Member, SPL and ASPL are the other members of the committee. The purpose of the committee is to create awareness about natural disaster among the school children and to help the government at the time of natural disaster.

### **Students Health Care**

- Montfort Valley School is always supporting the Government in health and hygiene. The timely health screenings are done by the PHSC departments.
- A session was organised for the students of Grade 6 to 9 on First Aid and demonstration of CPR on how to save oneself from fire accident and snake bite on by PHSC Staff on 30th July.
- Vaccination was given to the students of grade 5&10. On 16th July iron tablets were distributed for all the students.

The close of the 20th academic year marks not just the end of another cycle but a moment of profound reflection and celebration for Montfort Valley. As detailed in this report, the success of the 2025-26 academic year is a testament to the collective effort of the entire community.
